**Trip booking policy (updated 06-05-13):** All bookings require a trip deposit fee (as noted on the trip confirmation form) 30 days prior to trip date to reserve trip. Full-day trips last eight (8) hours (consecutive). Half-day trips last five (4) hours. No split trips are offered. Reel Angling Adventures reserves the right to cancel any trip at any time. Trip deposit fees are fully refunded on all trips canceled by Reel Angling Adventures. Gift certificate purchases do not expire and will not be refunded. Client cancellations are accepted until 8 days before the trip date and receive a full refund of the trip deposit fee. Trips are planned regardless of weather conditions (we fish in the rain); however, trips canceled or shortened for inclement weather (guide's call) will receive 1) a full refund for cancelled trip; or 2) a pro-rated refund, equal to the portion of the trip cancelled. Parties of more than two anglers require additional boats, unless otherwise arranged with Reel Angling Adventures. Custom rates and trip arrangements are available for large parties. All bookings include guide/guide boat (as required), rods/reels, lures/flyes, accessories, transportation to and from pick up location, bottled water, and photographing (high-resolutions digital images only, require photo release). Full-day trips include deli-style sandwich lunch.
